2nd Notes to Non-Local Participants

A. Arrival to Hong Kong

Please note that no pick up service will be provided by the Hong Kong Red Cross at the Hong Kong International Airport to Panda Hotel, where you will stay for the period from March 13-18, 2013. The Panda Hotel airport shuttle bus service is available at Airport Shuttle Bus Services Counter (B16) of Hong Kong International Airport Arrival Hall. A single trip fare of the airport shuttle will be charged at HK\$120 per person for the participating teams, with 2 pieces of luggage free of charge.

**Taking airport shuttle bus to the Hotel is one of the options for your convenience only. If there are 2 or more members in your delegation, you may consider taking a taxi (with meter charge and luggage charge \$5 per piece). Each team will be responsible for its own expenses.*

We strongly recommend non-local teams to check in the hotel first upon your arrival to ensure us you have safely arrived Hong Kong. If any teams do have special arrangement, please kindly notify us by email beforehand.

B. Reception

A reception counter will be set up by the Hong Kong Red Cross (HKRC) at the lobby of the hotel to welcome participants on March 13, from 13:00-20:00. All non-local teams should get the welcoming kits from the counter upon their arrival.

C. Fee Charged for additional accommodation

As stated in the previous Notes to Non-local Participants, free accommodation for 6days/5nights will be provided to 2 mooters and 1 team coach/researcher of each team (3 members). Any additional cost for additional members coming to Hong Kong and/or to be incurred by individual teams due to early arrival or extended stay in HK should be responsible by the teams themselves.

The fee will be collected at the HKRC's reception counter on March 13. The teams should prepare **Hong Kong currency** which can be exchanged at the airport or hotel.
