B. Arrival to Hong Kong

Please note that <u>no</u> pick up service will be provided by the Hong Kong Red Cross at the Hong Kong International Airport to Panda Hotel, where you will stay for the period from March 2-7, 2011. The Panda Hotel airport shuttle bus service is available at Airport Shuttle Bus Services Counter (A16 or B16) of Hong Kong International Airport Arrival Hall. A single trip fare of the airport shuttle will be charged at HK\$100 per person for the participating teams, with 2 pieces of luggage free of charge.
